NEW OR RENEWAL CERTIFICATION

Disclosure of Principals

The law requires you fully and accurately disclose in this application all information required by SLED. Accordingly, you are required to identify to SLED all principals involved in the operation of your electronic monitoring agency. A "principal" is any person who is authorized to exercise day-to-day operational direction and control of the practices and employees of your agency to include partners, directors and officers. Each principal in the agency must meet the same standards of character, background and integrity as the certification applicant.

Principals of electronic monitoring agencies must be of suitable character and background, as determined by SLED. Failure of a principal to meet and maintain such suitability requirements constitutes cause for suspension or revocation of the certification. A person who is not eligible to meet these suitability requirements is not eligible to be involved in the operation of your electronic monitoring agency.

False information presented in this application package is reason for denial of the application or, if discovered later, for revocation of the certification.
