***** NOTE: If an agency goes with a Partial/Limited NCIC client then they must have another NCIC client that provides all Hit Confirmation request/responses and Locates for all files.**

Four levels of validation are supported: Limited/Partial Inquiry, Full Inquiry, Full Function, and Mobile.

To meet validation the vendor(s) and/or contractor(s)'s application will be required to properly process the SLED/CJIS specified set of transactions.

Full Function:

Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) must provide all current and future NCIC/NLETS/SLED-CJIS transactions ensuring the reliability, confidentiality, completeness, and accuracy of all information contained or obtained for criminal justice purposes. Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will be given a set amount of time to provide agencies with any updated Technical and Operational Updates (TOU) that may be released throughout the year(s).

Full Inquiry:

Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) must supply all Query, Hit Confirmation, and Locate transactions in order to meet NCIC /NLETS/SLED-CJIS policies and procedures. Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will be given a set amount of time to provide agencies with any updated Technical and Operational Updates (TOU) that may be released throughout the year(s).

Limited/Partial Inquiry:

Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will provide a list of the most commonly used transactions. The vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) may extend this minimum set to include other less commonly used transactions to meet customer needs or market expectations. However, if an agency decides to use a vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) with this type of validation then the agency must have another 3rd party client in place that will access NCIC/NLETS/SLED-CJIS providing that agency with transactions in order to meet NCIC /NLETS/SLED-CJIS policies and procedures pertaining to Locates and Hit Confirmations.. If an agency enters records then the agency must have a 3rd party client who is Full Function. If an agency does not enter records and is not a 24 hour operation then the agency must have a 3rd party client who is Full Inquiry. Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will be given a set amount of time to provide agencies with any updated Technical and Operational Updates (TOU) that may be released throughout the year(s).

Mobile:

Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will provide a list of the most commonly used transaction for mobile. The vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) may extend this minimum set to include other less commonly used transactions to meet customer needs or market expectations. At this time SLED/CJIS will not allow any Criminal History transactions on Mobile. Vendor(s) and/or contractor(s) will be given a set amount of time to provide agencies with any updated Technical and Operational Updates (TOU) that may be released throughout the year(s).
