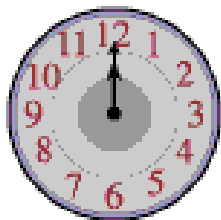

The crime clock should be viewed with care. Being the most aggregate representation of UCR data, it is designed to convey the annual reported crime experience by showing the relative frequency of occurrence of the index crimes. This mode of display should not be taken to imply a regularity in the commission of the index crimes; rather, it represents the annual ratio of crime to fixed time intervals.

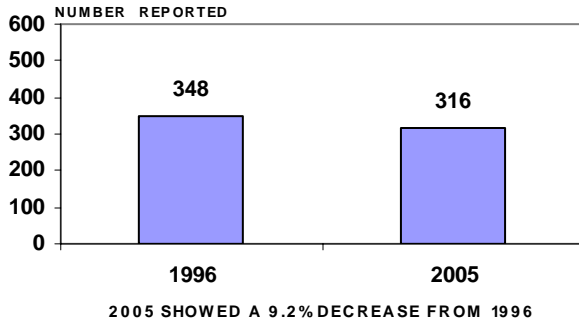

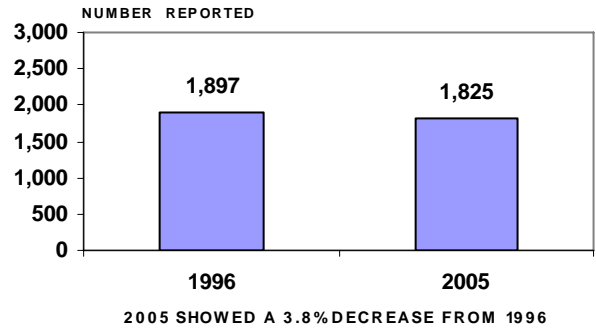

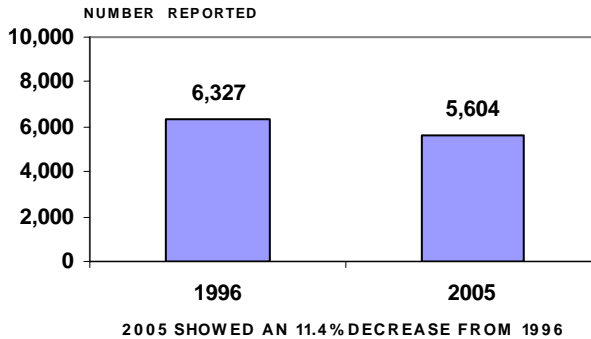
1996 vs. 2005
MURDER TREND



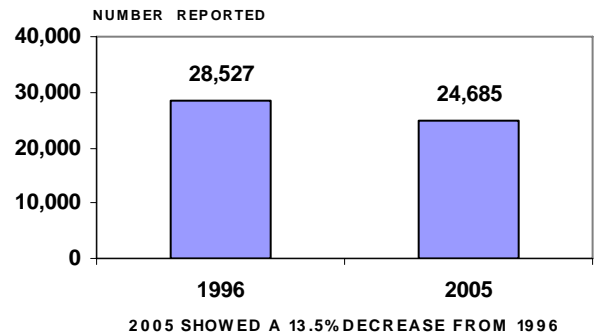
1996 vs. 2005
FORCIBLE RAPE TREND



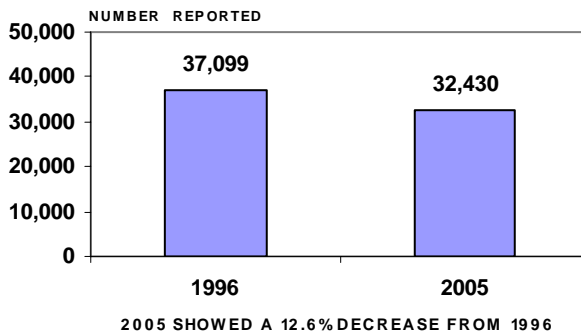
1996 vs. 2005
ROBBERY TREND



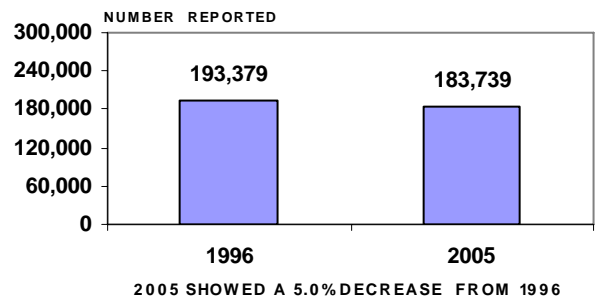
1996 vs. 2005

CLEARANCES

For crime reporting purposes, an index crime is cleared when a law enforcement agency has identified and located the offender and there is enough evidence to charge him. The arrest of one person can clear several crimes, or several persons may be arrested in clearing one crime. Clearances are recorded in exceptional circumstances when some element beyond law enforcement control precludes the arrest of the offender.
