For the purpose of testing of minors who may have consumed, purchased, or possessed alcoholic beverages, SLED hereby approves alcohol screening devices that appear, at the time of purchase, in the Conforming Products List of the Federal Register published by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation.
