MEMORANDUM

TO: All Private Security Company Licensees and Security Training Officers
FROM: Major Clifton Weir, SLED Regulatory Services
DATE: June 27, 2016
RE: **Private Security Statewide Training Seminars**

Recently all private security company licensees and security training officers were sent a memo from SLED Chief Mark Keel regarding changes to private security licensing, training, and regulation. That memo referenced upcoming mandatory training seminars to further discuss those changes and distribute the new approved security training material. The details of those seminars are enclosed, along with important information on who is required to attend and registration instructions.

Because sensitive information will be distributed during these seminars, attendance is strictly limited to those who have registered to attend on a particular date at a particular location. Each private security company licensee **or** his/her designee **and** each security training officer is required to attend. If your company utilizes more than one training officer, please indicate that during seminar registration. Likewise, please indicate during registration if your company receives training from a training officer employed by another company. Training materials will be distributed **only to the company licensee or his/her designee** at these seminars for distribution accountability. Licensees will then be responsible for appropriate distribution within their companies.

Attendance at one of these seminars is mandatory. Failure to attend may result in suspension or inability to renew a company license or decertification as a training officer.

The seminar registration form is enclosed with this memorandum along with the available seminar dates. Please complete the registration form and return to SLED as indicated no later than July 12, 2016. Only those registered will be allowed to attend. Additionally, SLED intends to update communication capabilities with private security companies. In an effort to better assist in that process, please include a valid email address on your seminar registration form.

Please bring your SLED security registration card with you to the seminar as it will be required for entry.
