

Background

You will have an opportunity to demonstrate your products to a large pool of potential customers. Accommodations

The conference this year will be held at the Adams Mark Hotel (soon to be Marriott) in downtown Columbia, South Carolina. The hotel has a good restaurant and a Sports Bar on the premises and many more are within walking distance. A trolley comes by every half hour and takes people to the Vista where they are many great restaurants and bars. The hotel also includes a fitness center.

The conference rate for the hotel is \$69 per night for a single or double; add \$10 for 3 or 4 people. Parking is included as well as a continental breakfast.
