SLED INVESTIGATING OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING IN GREENVILLE COUNTY

Agents of the S.C. Law Enforcement Division are investigating an incident from Saturday evening where a suspect was shot and killed in a confrontation with Deputies from the Greenville County Sheriff's Office. No other injuries are reported. Greenville County Deputies were attempting to serve a warrant when the incident took place.

SLED conducts law enforcement officer involved shooting investigations at the request of the agency involved in the incident. These independent investigations follow SLED's guidance in conducting interviews along with the gathering and analysis of forensic evidence. Interviews are being conducted with the responding officers and others.

Information gathered in the SLED investigation of the incident will be summarized in a case file report to be submitted to prosecutors.

This is an ongoing investigation. No other information about the case will be disclosed by SLED at this time. SLED will defer to the Greenville County Sheriff's Office for any information about their Deputies.

The incident in Greenville County was the 23rd officer involved shooting in South Carolina in 2020 and the first this year involving the Greenville Sheriff's Office. In 2019, there were 45 officer involved shootings in South Carolina; five involved the Greenville County Sheriff's Office.
