SLED CHARGES THREE MEN WITH MULTIPLE VEHICLE CRIMES IN ORANGEBURG COUNTY

Agents from the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) charged Frank Edwinn Easterlin,, 37 of Rowesville, SC, Jonathan Carter Easterlin, 31, of Orangeburg, SC, and Harvin Antwain Spigner, 40, of St. Matthews, SC each with multiple vehicle crimes.
