SLED CHARGES GREENVILLE COUNTY MAN WITH OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE

On Friday, agents from the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) arrested Brian Joseph Stoltie, 42, of Greenville, S.C. for Obstructing Justice. Previously, Stoltie was involved in an officer involved shooting in Anderson County and was charged with Attempted Murder in 2019. Stoltie was extradited from Pennsylvania Department of Corrections to face this charge in South Carolina.

Details from the investigation are in the attached warrants.

Stoltie was booked at the Anderson County Detention Center.

The case will be prosecuted by 10th Circuit Solicitor's Office.

being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant Brian Joseph Stoltie
did within this county and state on or about 1/8/2020 violate the criminal laws of the
State of South Carolina (or ordinance of County/ Municipality of Anderson)
in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Obstructing / Obstructing justice

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit
the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on or about April 26, 2019, while in Anderson County, Brian Joseph Stoltie was ordered by the Honorable J. Wesley White, an
Anderson County Magistrate Judge, not to depart the State of South Carolina without the permission of the court and to be of good
behavior. That between the dates of January 8, 2020, and April 24, 2020, the defendant did intentionally leave the State of South
Carolina and travel to the State of Pennsylvania without the permission of the courts or solicitor's office. That during this same time
period, defendant has committed multiple criminal offenses and has not complied with the court's order. That these acts are
intentional violations of a valid South Carolina court order and that these intentional acts did prevent, obstruct, impeded and/or
hinder the administration of justice in Anderson County.
