being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant Lilli Marie Russell did within this county and state on or about 8/20/2022 violate the criminal laws of the

State of South Carolina (or ordinance of County/ Municipality of Beaufort) in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Lottery / Intent to defraud, counterfeit game tickets; alter, make, etc.

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

That between August 20, 2022 and August 22, 2022, the defendant, Lillie Russell, did with intent to defraud, unlawfully pass nine (9) stolen South Carolina Education Lottery "Cash Pop" tickets, at seven (7) different SCEL retailer locations inside the county limits of Beaufort, South Carolina. The defendant did receive a cash payout of nine hundred and seventy dollars (\$970.00) collectively from the stores. The tickets were previously stolen by the defendant from Parkers #59, located at 3462 Trask Pkwy, Beaufort (Beaufort County), SC where she was employed at the time of the theft. The defendant was identified by employee records and admitted to passing the stolen tickets after voluntarily waiving her Miranda rights during an interview. The interview was video and audio recorded by SA Jackson. The affiant and others are witness to prove the same.
