I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On or about February 2, 2024, Anthony Inman, within the county of Dillon, committed the offense of Misconduct in Office, to wit: Inman, while serving as a deputy with Dillon County Sheriff's Office, did contact a potential subject of a criminal investigation to request that she delete information from a cell phone including text messages between Inman and the subject. Inman admitted the text messages were sexual in nature. While Inman and another investigator were enroute to collect the cell phone, Inman warned the subject they were coming to collect said cell phone. The cell phone contained potential evidence for possible crimes committed in Dillon County. The Affiant's belief is based upon post Miranda statements from the defendant and text messages received through a search warrant. This being in violation of South Carolina Code of Laws.
