SLED CHARGES THREE LANCASTER COUNTY INMATES WITH FENTANYL OFFENSES FOLLOWING AN INMATE OVERDOSE

On Thursday, March 7, 2024, agents with the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) charged inmate Destiny Sierra Hinson, 23, with Distribution of Fentanyl, and inmates Wynter Rose Hilburn, 27, and Stephanie Renee Clark, 32, with Possession of Contraband – Fentanyl.

On March 3, 2024, SLED was requested by the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office to investigate the apparent drug overdose of a Lancaster County Detention Center inmate.

Details can be found in the attached warrants.

Hinson, Hilburn and Clark remain at the Lancaster County Detention Center.

The case will be prosecuted by the 6th Circuit Solicitor's Office.

I/M Hinson committed the offense when she unlawfully smuggled fentanyl upon her person into LCDC and distributed this narcotic to LCDC I/M Wynter Hilburn. I/M Hinson's narcotic was ultimately distributed to multiple inmates inside J-Cell. I/M use of this narcotic inside J-Cell facilitated an irreversible medical emergency that led to being declared brain dead on March 5, 2024. During a cell search by SLED Crime Scene agents, law enforcement located a powdery substance in two locations inside J-Cell that did field test positive for fentanyl. I/M Hinson was identified as the suspect by LCDC documents, LCDC video surveillance, and witness statements.
