2023, violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above
did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the
following facts:

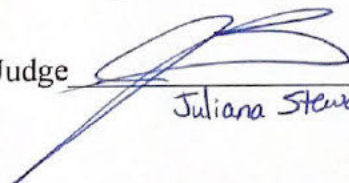
That on or between February 2019 and July 2023, in Dorchester County, South
Carolina, the defendant Lynn Evans Myers; did willingly, knowingly, and without the
lawful will to do so, take, steal or convert to her ownership, more than \$10,000.00 from
her employer, the St. George United Methodist Church, where she held a position of trust
and feloniously violated S.C. statute of *Breach of Trust with Fraudulent Intent,*
\$10,000.00 or more 16-13-230 with malice aforethought.

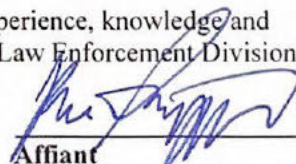
Between the dates of February 2019, and July 2023, the defendant, Lynn Evans
Myers, while employed at the St. George United Methodist Church, who in her position
had the responsibility of safekeeping, transferring and dispersing Church funds, did take,
steal, or convert to her ownership these funds with the intent to deprive the St. George
United Methodist Church. The defendant used St. George United Methodist Church
credit cards to purchase approximately \$39,364.34 worth of services/goods for personal
use through Apple.com. The defendant also deposited \$12,300.00 of the St. George
United Methodist Church funds into her personal South State Bank Acct#
[REDACTED] for her own personal gain. It was determined that the approximate total
amount of currency that was taken, stolen or converted to her ownership by the defendant
Lynn Evans Myers exceeded \$51,664.34.

The above facts are believable based on the experience, knowledge and
investigation conducted jointly by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.
