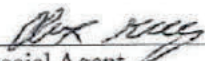

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Fraudulent Application for a Driver's License

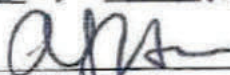
I further state that there is probable cause to believe the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on October 19, 2022, the defendant entered the West Ashley branch of the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) located at 946 Orleans Rd unit F7, which is in Charleston County, and fraudulently obtained a South Carolina Driver's License (SCDL) in the name of [REDACTED]. The defendant fraudulently identified himself as [REDACTED], fraudulently presented the personal identifying information for [REDACTED], and was issued a SCDL in [REDACTED]'s name.
